The 2023-2024 school year will be here in just a short time, and we are so busy getting everything ready for you! The science lab has had a major renovation this summer! We have 5 student islands, a fume hood, Bunsen burners, and a safety shower. The awning between the main building and Hemenway Hall has been replaced, and bulletin boards have been added to display creative student work. Grades kindergarten – seventh will enjoy new innovative editions of *Math in Focus!*

Baby/Toddler Saints:
