Spanish Instruction (Grades 5–8)

- Implement an established curriculum that emphasizes fluency, pronunciation, grammar, and cultural understanding.
- Use a variety of instructional strategies, including kinesthetic games, performance-based assessments, skits, cooking lessons, sports activities in Spanish, and/or other cultural explorations.
- Encourage students to apply their Spanish language skills in real-life and creative contexts.
- Assess student progress through class participation, homework, oral and written evaluations, performance-based tasks, and projects.

- Strong classroom management and communication skills
- Ability to integrate technology into instruction (e.g., media lab projects, language apps)
